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ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

In recognising its primary aim of providing security and crowd management to make safe events and venues, PSSSL is also aware of its responsibility to the environment, and where practicable tries to ensure it reduces its environmental impact through using the principals of reducing, reusing and recycling. Working within the office the PSSSL adheres to the policies in operations, where possible using the electronic format.

Reducing

The Company looks to use contractors and suppliers that are local, reducing the number of vehicle journeys used in delivering specified services. Our staff are local staff, who are actively encouraged to use public transport. Where this is not possible, we lay on coach or minibus to transport staff to reduce vehicle journeys.

Re using

The aim is to ensure where possible any products can be reused. It has stores for uniforms generic event /site equipment to ensure new purchases are kept to a minimum. It uses where possible rechargeable portable electrical equipment. This extends to general signage ensuring it is printed on reusable material and is designed where possible to not be event specific.

Recycle

PSSSL looks to recycle all standard waste products from its site, not only general office material but extends to catering and concession material and uniforms.

It encourages all contractors to put in place the priority to use recycled products.

- Continue to reuse and recycle products where possible and to explore new avenues for the recycling and reuse of materials where it is commercially beneficial.
- Minimise and dispose of unavoidable waste in a safe and responsible manner.
- Ensuring that our road transport vehicles are used efficiently to minimise our contributions to road congestion and pollution.
- Communicate the policy externally to our suppliers, customers, contractors and internally to all our employees ensuring that they understand and implement the relevant aspects of the programme.
- Annually review our progress and monitor our achievements against set targets and objectives.
